Pasadena Club Star Wins Amateur Golf Tourney

Clearwater, Fla., March 26 (UN)—In a match which went six additional holes to the forty-second, John F. Dailey, Jr., of Pasadena, won the Florida amateur golf title from H. B. K. Davis of Belleair, one up on the Clearwater golf and country club course Friday.

Both played their best golf after the thirty-sixth hole in the final match for the championship.

Dailey was leading two up at the end of the 18 in the morning. In the afternoon they fought even throughout, reaching the thirty-sixth even. Davis was a bit nervous but shot good golf during the remaining six.

A poor drive on the forty-second caused Davis to lose it. He was about an inch from the cup on the third shot while Dailey sank his putt on the third.
