

STATE GOLF MEET

147 Entries Ready for Play at Jacksonville Today

Jacksonville, April 3.—AP—One hundred and forty-seven golfers, representing nearly every community in the state, were gathered here tonight for the opening round of the Florida state golf tournament, which begins tomorrow on Timuquana's fairways and adjacent rough.

Among the favorites who are expected to be in the running until the last rounds, are Al Ulmer of Jacksonville, four times winner of the title; Tommy Aycock of Jacksonville, Yale student, who has returned to defend his crown, he being the present titleholder; Gordon Gibbons of Tampa, who twice held the crown; T. W. Palmer of Miami, another who twice previously has won the tournament, and Lawrence Sherrill of Tampa, a semi-finalist of last year's meeting at Orlando.
