

Qualifying Fee: \$75 (\$85 - members who do not have an active FSGA/GHIN Handicap).

**Championship Format**: 36 holes of stroke play on Thursday and Friday to identify the low 32 for match play. (The low 32 will have the lowest 36-hole scores) Match play begins Friday afternoon with the final match on Sunday afternoon.
