JACK VEGHTE. BOB RANKIN IN EXHIBITION WITH LEE TREVINO AT LONGBOAT KEY

Two former State Amateur Champions, Jack Veghte and Bob Rankin, will play in the Lee Trevino exhibition match for Kiwanis Charity at Longboat Key Golf Club, Sarasota, Monday, March 13, 1972. Sarasota professional Bob Deakin will be the fourth participant in the match. Rankin won his title in 1969 when the championship was played at Longboat and he scored an even par 288 for the 72 hole test. Veghte is a two time winner with victories in 1968 at Panama City when his nine under par 279 fell a stroke short of John Darr's record and a win at Tomoka Oaks, Ormond Beach, in 1970. Precedent was set for FSGA Champions to play in the exhibition at Longboat last year when former FSGA Junior Champions Gary Koch and Eddie Pearce played the match with Arnold Palmer and Gary Player.

SCHOLARSHIPS AGAIN FOR LAKE CITY JUNIOR COLLEGE
