Tournament Chairmen Meet in Tampa

Tournament Chairman's meeting was held on October 28 in Tampa for all the Tournament Chairmen in the state. In all, 18 Tournament Chairmen and FSGA staff attended the day long meeting to discuss FSGA tournament administration.

The meeting began with introducing **Bob Forward** as a new Tournament Chairman. Bob, the golf pro and general manger at Lake Wales Country Club, serves on the PGA Rules Committee and will be a great addition.

The FSGA will continue to enforce the qualifications for all Tournament Chairmen and Rules Officials to include mandatory attendance of a PGA/ USGA Rules Seminar at least once every four years and a minimum score of 85 on the PGA/USGA Rules of Golf exam.

Congratulations to **Don Roberts**, **Bob McClure** and **Ted Burfeind** for meeting the requirements to be certified Rules Officials. These men have all attended a PGA/USGA Rules Seminar and achieved a score of 85 or above on the exam within the past four years.

Many other topics were discussed including encouraging volunteers to fill out profiles so we have a better understanding on where volunteers should be placed. Also, the Rules Workshops are posted for everyone to sign up and Tournament 101 Workshops will be available for registration shortly. The meeting went over some additional topics pertaining to Tournament Chairmen such as the Lightning Policy, Pace of Play, hole locations and much more.

Overall, the meeting was designed to look back on the season and acknowledge the strengths and weaknesses and continue to build and improve the quality of tournament administration in all FSGA events.

The FSGA encourages every Member Club to attend a USGA/FSGA Handicap Certification Seminar in order that each club achieve certification in the USGA Handicap System. It is important that every FSGA Member Club assume their responsibility and strongly encourage golf/handicap committee members and club staff to attend these seminars.
