

Volunteer Spotlight - Mike Lonergan

Mike Lonergan has been volunteering with the FSGA for close to two years and he has already totaled more than 45 events, including USGA and FSGA events.

Born and raised in Leavenworth, Kansas, Mike attended Rockhurst College in Kansas City, receiving a degree in Business Management. Mike's 93 year old mother still lives in Leavenworth in the same house she moved into after she married Mike's father. After college, Mike joined the Army Reserve and was stationed in Milwaukee. It was there that he met his wife of 43 years. Mike and Marianne moved many times around the country during his career in consumer products, commercial furniture sales and management. He first started out in sales at Colgate Palmolive for 15 years in various locations and then joined Boise Cascade Office Products in Chicago. With these experiences, he then worked for a variety of commercial furniture companies in the US. They moved to Coral Springs in January 2000 to work for Loewenstein Furniture and subsequently worked for a Danish company that allowed him to work from anywhere he wished. In 2002, they chose The Villages, by accident. "We were visiting some friends and we thought this

place was like Disneyland for adults," said Mike. "We sold our home, moved and lived happily ever after." On New Years Eve of 2005, Mike retired. "Because of my work and travel for over 40 years, I couldn't really play a lot of golf and volunteer," said Mike. "I had lots of energy and time and wanted to give something back to the game that I loved."




Mike found the FSGA through a friend and took the initiative to start volunteering. When he showed up at his first tournament at Alaqua Lakes there were a few other residents of The Villages who Mike was randomly paired up with to play golf with the day prior. They never discussed volunteering with the FSGA and by coincident, they all showed up at the same event. "My first experience was wonderful," said Mike. "I had a great time." Mike signed up for more events and since January 2006, he has volunteered his time at more than 45 tournaments. "I enjoy watching great golf and I understand the game so much more now," said Mike. "I like meeting all the competitors and working with the staff." There are now 13 volunteers from The Villages who travel together to different events. "We have a wonderful relationship." said Mike. "We like talking about the USGA Rules." They like the Rules so much they have a monthly get together in The Villages to discuss the Rules of Golf. The Villages

gang continuously talks up the FSGA and recruits volunteers from their area. They are credited for introducing many new volunteers to the FSGA. Mike also enjoys working with the juniors. A memorable experience for him was last fall when he watched Alexis Thompson who at 11 years of age played and won an FJT girls 16-18 age division event at Disney. "I was so impressed," said Mike. "It's fun to follow her career now, note her significant maturity and progress." Mike also helps at NCAA tournaments and hopes to become a certified Rules Official. He has already attended an FSGA Rules Seminar and plans on attending a USGA/PGA Rules Seminar next year. He is also the Certificated Handicap Chairman for one of The Villages clubs.

With nine golf courses to choose from at The Villages, Mike plays golf at least three days a week working to continue to lower his current 7 handicap. Besides his involvement in golf, Mike manages a small sales and marketing consultant business on the side. Mike and Marianne have two children, a son living in Peoria, Illinois and a daughter in San Antonio, Texas. Together, they have six grandchildren.
