

# Life begins at 40 for Lakeland's Lamar Pilgrim

**LEHIGH**  
Lamar Pilgrim of Lakeland held off defending champion Ron Clayton of Sarasota with a closing-round 68 and won the overall championship in the Florida State GA's Life

Begins at 40 tournament last weekend at Lehigh CC.

Pilgrim's opening-round 71 gave him a one-shot lead over Clayton and two shots over former FSGA president Chip Anderson of Boca Raton. Pilgrim followed with a 68 to go up by two over Clayton, who had a 69.

His closing 68 gave Pilgrim a nine-under-par 207 total while Clayton again shot 69 for 210. Anderson finished with 72-71 for 216.

Andy Moore of Sarasota won the 40-49 age division, closing with 77 for 232.

The 50-59 division was broken down into three flights. Jack Collins of Sarasota won the first at 218, Bob Grossman of Vero Beach took the second at 239, and Richard Hysell of Sarasota, who played the par-three 18th hole with ace, birdie, par the three days, won the third at 255.

Bob Winchester of Melbourne overcame a seven-shot deficit and defeated George Thompson of Marco Island on a match of cards in the 60-64 first flight. Both finished with 228 totals. John Schaul of Sarasota won the second flight at 247 on a match of cards over Grady White of Melbourne, while Maurice LaVista took the third flight at 259.

Red Henriksen of Lake Worth, who was in the running for the overall title, won the 65-69 first flight with 71-71-74--216. Gene Byrne of Oviedo was the second flight winner at 237 while Paul Baiwir of Tampa had 253 to take the third flight.

Carl Gustafson of Cape Coral captured the 70-over first flight at 229 while Don Schwartz of Naples won the second flight at 268 after a match of cards against Hugh Coates of Tampa.
