Dear Bob:

Short summary of the final day action.

Dick Rigabar commenced the round on Sunday with a one stroke lead over Ron Clayton and a two stroke advantage over Rick Myrick.

At the conclusion of nine holes both Clayton and Myrick turned at 36 and Rigabar posted a 39 which put Clayton with a one and two stroke advantage over his closest opponents.

On the 11th hole Rigabar started a hat trick of birdies. This gave him a one stroke lead over Clayton. Clayton answered with a birdie on hole number 15 to tie the match. Clayton made a bogey on hole sixteen while Rigabar carded a par and Myrick recorded a birdie. Rigabar proceeded to birdie hole number 17 to give him a two stroke advantage going in to the final par three 18th hole.

Rigabar's tee shot struck a palm tree to the right of the green a bounced back into a lateral water hazard. In the ensuing confusion over where to drop the ball from the hazard Rigabar decided to drop on the far side of the lateral hazard and proceed to play the shot without waiting for a ruling from the rules committee. His approach shot was bunkered with a fried egg lie and the next shot was over the green. His final score of six on the hole gave Ron Clayton his fourth Life Begins at Forty Championship by two strokes. Rick Myrick finished second and Rigabar third.

The best round of the day was carded by Dr. W. Earl Morris of Naples who played in the 65-69 age division and carded a 71 for a total of 223.
