

STATE MID-AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP

At Bear Lakes Country Club, Tom Case added a second State Mid-Amateur Championship to his resume. The 1989 winner walked off of the seventh green of his semifinal match 4 holes down to host club member Eric Schreiber. Never changing his routine or expression, the Ft. Myers insurance executive slowly whittled away at the deficit, finally winning the 18th hole for a 2 up victory. Temple Terrace's Brian Hawke earned his place in the final match by defeating 1994 Champion John Corzilius (Nokomis). Case displayed the same tenacity in the final to take the title by a 4-3 margin.

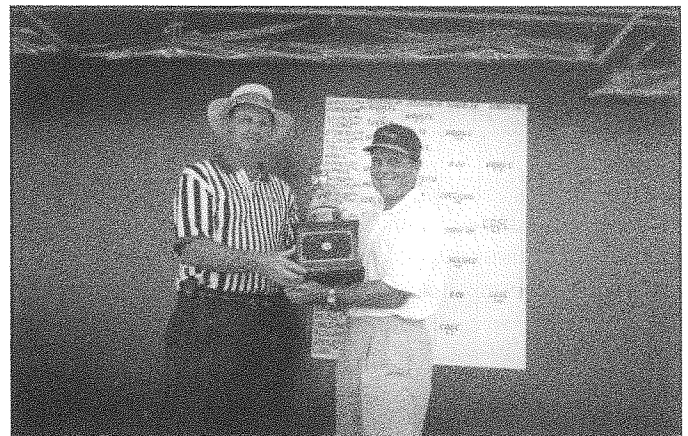
