What to Wear and Bring

Our goal as Tournament Officials is to be like a golf ball; easily identifiable to players. It is essential for all Tournament Officials to be dressed in the same uniform so we can easily be identified by players, club officials and spectators alike when needed.

It is also extremely important to bring some basic items along with you while officiating at an event. Many Officials bring a "Rules Bag" with them and keep it in their cart to not only take care of their own needs, but also assist the competitors in the field.

Uniform Policy

• The FSGA uniform includes khaki pants, a white FSGA logo shirt and a name tag. Men may wear khaki shorts for course rating, but are required to wear long pants for tournaments. Women have the option of wearing khaki pants, shorts or a skirt for tournaments or course rating. White, colored, or khaki FSGA logo caps, straw hats, or visors may be worn.

Exception

Similar to the Rules of Golf, there is an exception to the Uniform Policy from the months
of June through September. During these months, male volunteers have the option to
wear khaki shorts. However, during the U.S. Open Sectional, the Amateur, the Women's
Amateur, the Florida Open, and the Florida Senior Open Championships, all male
volunteers must wear khaki pants.

What to Bring

- Rules book and/or Decisions book
- Extra towel
- String to measure golf balls that may be out of bounds
- Binoculars to help spot golf balls
- Sunglasses
- Watch or Stop Watch
- Water
- A snack or two
